In line with the Kennel Club's **Operational Plan for the Resumption of Field Trials** competitors should be aware of the Society's additional entry conditions.

1. The draw and Field Trial card will be sent electronically
2. Competitors must provide their own face masks and hand sanitiser to be used at the appropriate times.
3. Competitors are required to provide their own number for identification purposes. Whilst this need not be an armband it must be clearly visible to the judge when joining the line.
4. Spectators are not allowed on the trial ground.
5. An appointed individual, ideally from the same household would be required to hold an additional dog where a competitor is running a second dog.
6. If a competitor or anyone in their household has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must not attend the ground and should self - isolate in line with Government advice.
7. Competitors must not attend the trial if they reside in an area covered by a local Government enforced lock down.

The Covid Safety officer for this event is Mrs J Reed

Conditions of Entry:

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations and Registration B.
2. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an ATC number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. If the entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
4. Should circumstances so dictate the Society in consultation with the judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
5. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club followed by an advertisement in the appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
6. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
7. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS:** Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.
If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for damage caused.
8. **Welfare of Dogs:** An exhibitor or competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action default omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
9. Videography and photography will only be allowed with the express permission of the chief steward and the host.
